Bournemouth University Disaster Management Centre (BUDMC) designs and delivers world-class training and technical assistance in Disaster Management. Most staff time is spent a broad delivering these services, tailored to the needs of government ministries, police, emergency services, military, international agencies, non-governmental organisations and industry.

Each year BUDMC sets aside time in UK to run a number of International Disaster Management Training and Briefing Weeks. The programme covers a wide scope of disaster management topics including:

The course is delivered by staff of BUDMC and Bournemouth University's other academic schools as well as by guest lecturers. The Course Director will be Richard Gordon, Director BUDMC. The course is highly interactive and, with some modules running in parallel, allows participants to select subject areas most relevant to their current or future career needs.

Course fees are £1,250 inclusive. Fees cover the costs of tuition, all training materials, plus full residential costs including all meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner), and coffee and tea breaks during the working day.
