Recommendations for the ISDR system (list 2 or 3 items):	 Considering the importance of effective post disaster recovery to recognise that IRP is firmly established as a thematic platform of ISDR system and as a global catalyst for better recovery Demonstrated value of IRP through a number of tangible outcomes, e.g. international Forum, report on Learning from Disaster Recovery based on lessons from past disasters, progress on development of tools for better coordination and capacity building programme Need to expand the Community of Practice focussed on recovery and ensure active participation of stakeholders at all levels (Govt.at all levels, community, NGOs, IFIs, Donors, UN agencies, etc.) Strengthen collaboration and attract more partner organisations – donors and particularly high risk countries
