HFA IMPLEMENTATION IN THE PHILIPPINES

The National Disaster Coordinating Council (NDCC) is the highest policy-making and coordinating body for disaster risk management in the Philippines. It advises the President on matters related to natural calamities and disasters, including recommendations for the declaration of a state of calamity in disaster-affected areas. The Secretary of National Defense serves as the Chairman of the NDCC and the Council is composed of fourteen (14) Department Secretaries, the Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP), the Secretary-General of the Philippine National Red Cross (PNRC), and the Administrator of Office of Civil Defense (OCD) as member and Executive Officer.

A line bureau under the Department of National Defense (DND), OCD has been the focal agency in the country on disaster management. It had initiated the crafting of a Comprehensive Disaster Management Framework with four (4) main elements, namely; Mitigation, Preparedness, Response and Rehabilitation for which several programs and activities are being implemented not only by OCD but also by the member-agencies of the NDCC. The Council has a Calamities and Disaster Preparedness Plan which spells out the functions of each member agency in times of disasters.

The OCD represented the Philippines in the January 2005 – World


