#### Job purpose:

Reporting to the Somaliland Programme manager, the Project Manager FIM is responsible for ensuring the effective and quality implementation of Food, Income & Markets activities in Somaliland, in coherence with the WASH interventions as part of a new four year integrated programme being implemented by Concern in the region. 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### Project Development and Management
