Purpose of this position:

The MRCS Communication officer for Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) will be in charge of all internal and external communication tools and events towards risk reduction initiatives, which will be implemented under the 5 years MRCS/FRC Disaster Risk Reduction Coastal Area program.

The MRCS Communication officer for Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) will also assist the DRR teams in all issues related to risk perception and risk acceptance of the audience targeted.

The MRCS Disaster Risk Reduction coastal program Coordinator will work in closed coordination with the FRC DRR program coordinator and their respective team.

The MRCS Communication officer for Disaster Risk Reduction (DRR) will be also the main link between the DRR unit and the existing MRCS communication division for any communication activities

Main Responsibilities:

- To develop good partner relationships with all Myanmar Red Cross society staff and volunteers, relevant government authorities, scientific organizations, international organizations and nongovernmental organizations, according to the DRR projects activities and areas concerned.
- Develop internal communication framework towards the DRR team itself as well as towards MRCS governance, others divisions, units and staff members and Red Cross partners.
- Develop good partner relationships with all news media stakeholders (radio, newspaper, magazine, movies maker, artists...), associations, private company...
- Assist the different DRR team to find out the optimal communication supports for developing their DRR activities, according to the audience targeted.
- Create & develop IEC tools support, articles, radio message, etc... on request of the DRR Program Coordinator.
- Conduct small scale pre-testing sessions with the target groups of any tools or messages created.
- Undertake surveys on Risk perception and Risk acceptance towards communities at risk selected under the DRR coastal program.
- Facilitate exchange of information in order to understand the nature and perception of risk towards the communities at risk, and formulate adequate messages and supports needed (awareness, warning or alert message ...) according to.
- Realize regular reportage photos and interviews of the DRR program activities.
- Select any external technical consultancy needed as graphic specialist based on quality, quantity & delivery time expected.
- Define the approval procedures needed for each potential IEC or others communication supports and tools.
- Ensure the proper approval process towards MRCS Communication head of division, MRCS Governance as well as ministries concerned if required.
- Create a follow up chart of any creation support in process or future plan.
- Organize regular exhibitions or events on DRR at National, divisional, township and villages levels. (e.g.: International Disaster Reduction day, Risk educational campaign, public awareness campaign ...).
- Realize impact assessment of each IEC tools, events and exhibitions created.
