Background

The Online Course conducted by NIDM is a step further to make our society disaster resilient.

The National Institute of Disaster Management constituted under the Disaster Management Act 2005 has been entrusted with the nodal national responsibility for human resource development, capacity building, training, research, documentation and policy advocacy in the field of Disaster Risk Management. The organization gives policy support to Union & State Governments for providing support and advises on Disaster Risk Reduction strategies. It conducts in-house as well as outreach training programmes in addition to Online Courses for various levels of stakeholders.

NIDM Online Course

The Institute is offering Online Courses on Disaster Risk Management in collaboration with the World Bank (GFDRR) Washington. The aim of this Programme is to raise the level of Awareness and Preparedness as well as to enhance analytical skills and professional competencies of distant key stakeholders in different areas of Disaster Risk Management. The NIDM online course is first of its kind in India which helps distant users in acquiring knowledge base in the subject. The course also facilitates participants to globally share their views, ideas and information on a common platform.
