## Achievements

- ✓ **Created collaboration and mutual learning among countries:**
  - Exchange programme (including through EC support] Sweden/UK; Sweden Austria; Bosnia and Herzegovina/the Netherlands, Albania/Italy, Croatia UK; etc....
  
- ✓ **Developed knowledge and addressed gaps through WG:**
  - Information sharing (bulletin);
  - CCA/DRR: shared experiences, developed key messages to be used at fora such as the COPs; Local Level Group: overview on NP level at the local level



- ✓ **Increased coordination, collaboration and harmonization among regional/international partners towards supporting national/local efforts**
  - Use of HFA Europe Report Recommendations;
  - Presence of Regional Partners: information sharing;
  - Use of EC Exchange Programme
  - Organization of back to back meetings
  
- ✓ **Contributed to the HFA2 consultations**
  
- ✓ **Supported NP developments: contribution CofE EUR-OPA, exchanges among countries: Austria - Germany, Sweden, Norway and UNISDR**



- ✓ Pioneered new work: 1<sup>st</sup> ever PEER Review on the HFA in the UK, Finland next month, Turkey and other countries expressed interest (partnership EC, UNISDR and OECD)
- ✓ Developed recommendations - state of art by Co-Chair.
- ✓ Created the enabling environment

## Towards a post-2015 DRR Framework

- Requested by the UN General Assembly Resolution A/RES/66/199
- UNISDR is facilitating a multistakeholder consultation process and engages a full range of actors from Member States to civil society.
- Consultation events include the Global and Regional Platforms, national and local events, and targeted events of stakeholders, partners and networks.
- Builds on the *International Framework for the International Decade for Natural Disaster Reduction of 1989*, the *Yokohama Strategy and Plan of Action of 1994*, the *International Strategy for Disaster Reduction of 1999*, the *Hyogo Framework for Action 2005-2015: Building the Resilience of Nations and Communities to Disasters (HFA)*, and the *Mid-Term Review of the HFA (2010-2011)*.
- Expected to be adopted at the Third UN World Conference on Disaster Risk Reduction and endorsed by the UN General Assembly in 2015.
