

"Workshop on Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction"

Background

- 1. The "Sendai Framework for Disaster Risk Reduction 2015-2030 (SFDRR)" was adopted at the 3rd UN World Conference on DRR (March 2015, Japan), and will serve as an international guideline for DRR for the next 15 years.
- 2. At the 4th Trilateral Ministerial Meeting on Disaster Management held in October 2015, the three Parties decided to strengthen cooperation from two aspects: 1) promoting the implementation of the SFDRR, and 2) education and training. They agreed to utilize existing education and training institutes in the three countries, such as UNISDR's ONEA/GETI in the ROK, ADRC in Japan and NDRCC in China, to develop government officials' capacities for disaster management and DRR. The three countries also agreed to transfer their technology and experiences to developing countries.

Purpose:

- To implement the outcome of the 4th Trilateral Ministerial Meeting on Disaster Management (October 2015, Japan)
- 2. To enhance government officials' understanding of the SFDRR by facilitating discussion on its implementation and particularly the role expected from the government


