Zoe Nash is a British woman who managed to survive two disasters: the Tsunami in Thailand in 2004 and the earthquake in Nepal in 2015. She returned to Nepal to Help Earthquake Victims

Petra Nemcova survived the 2004 Indian Ocean tsunami with serious injuries by holding on to a tree for 8 hours. She has started a global initiative to improve early warnings against extreme weather, and build resilient Societies

Stories and Experiences shared by survivors of disasters are essential in rallying community and public support for risk reduction programs engaging more people in understanding the increasing risk of climate change on the increasing rate and intensity of extreme weather events which likely lead to disasters.
